### Calculation of GPA and Ranking

GPA's are calculated on a four-point (4.0), unweighted scale with the exception of Honors and AP courses. Class rank is calculated to the thousandth decimal and includes all classes that receive a letter grade. Class ranking is calculated each semester and is cumulative.
