### GENERAL – ALL 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students

- Two face coverings to fit student (cloth or plastic)
- Laptop & charger (see reverse)
- One 3-ring binder with tabs for each subject
- Notebook paper 8 ½ x 11, 2 – 175 ct. pkgs.
- Pencils, regular or mechanical (extra lead)
- Pens, fine tip, 2 each—blue, black & red ink
- Colored pencils or markers
- Scissors
- Ruler (standard and metric)
- Glue stick
- Box or pouch for art supplies
- Highlighters
- Poster board (as needed for projects)

(Ex: Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS or TI-30Xa. *Casio brand calculators are not recommended*).

# BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD) PLAN FOR 2021-2022 AND BEYOND

- **7th - 8th grade students** will need a fully charged laptop with charger to be used both on-campus and at home each day.
  - Although these students will not be using their personal devices every day in every class, it is important that they have their device & charger with them so that they are prepared to do so.
- **9th - 12th grade students** will need a fully charged laptop with charger to be used both on-campus and at home each day.
  - Teachers will regularly utilize our various tech tools and platforms with high school students, thus necessitating a one-to-one device expectation.

- Installations:

  - Zoom App
  - Windows Defender Antivirus (build into the Windows 10 software)
  - Microsoft Office 365 Suite software (provided at no cost by SCS)

- Headphones
- Power/adaptor cord
- Protective Case

In an effort to streamline tech support and ensure all devices are operating properly, it is **strongly recommended** that any student currently using a Mac/iOS or Chromebook device either acquire a PC/Windows device or, if there is a need by the family, a student may request a school-issued laptop through the office for usage next year. *If your student used their MAC/iOS device successfully on campus during the past school year, they can continue to use that device knowing there may be limited support available.*
